GRAND TOUR of INDIA

October 29, 2008



Day 1 Toronto-Frankfurt

This evening, we depart Toronto for our overnight flight to Frankfurt. Services on Board.

Day 2 Frankfurt-Chennai

After arriving in Frankfurt, we proceed for our continuing flight to Chennai. After arriving shortly after midnight, we proceed through immigration & customs formalities then proceed to our hotel for check in and a good night's sleep.

Day 3 Chennai

After breakfast, we shall start our tour at 10 AM and visit the National Bronze Museum, Hindu Temple, Cathedral of St. Tome and drive along Marine Drive viewing Old Fort St George, Ice House etc. We continue on for lunch at Fisherman's Cove situated on the Bay of Bengal and then on to Mamallapuram. It is an open air museum in carved rock. Arjuns Penance, the world's largest bas relief in stone; the Shore Temple which has stood by the sea for 12 centuries. Return to Chennai

Day 4 Chennai-Madurai

This morning we depart for our short flight to Madurai. After arriving in Madurai we proceed to our hotel for check in. Later we proceed to visit the Palace of Thirumalai Nayak, the famous king of The Nayak Dynasty. On to see the magnificent structure of Dravidian architecture –The Meenakshi Temple Return to hotel.

Day 5 Madurai-Spice Village-Kumarakom

We leave at 8AM for our bus journey to Thekkady. Here we will have a Spice Plantation Tour which is so very educational, stop at a shop for Spices and then have lunch at the Spice Village. After we shall continue on passing by rubber and coconut plantations to our resort on Lake Vembanand. It is home to a large bird sanctuary.

Day 6 Kumarakom-Houseboat- Allepey

After a leisurely morning, our luggage will be transferred onto a houseboat. At noon we shall depart and proceed through the backwaters of Kerala viewing village life along the banks of the canals

Day 7 Allepey-Cochin

After breakfast we arrive at Allepey and then board our bus to continue on to Cochin. It is about 2 hour drive and the rest of the afternoon at leisure. We are here for 2 nights so laundry etc can be given. At 5:30 we will leave the hotel to the theatre to see the Famous Kathakali Dance performance famous in Kerala. After return to the to the hotel for dinner.

Day 8 Cochin

After breakfast we start our city tour in Old Fort cochin where we visit St.Francis Church, one of the oldest in India, see the Chinese fishing nets and then on to Mattancherry Dutch Palace built in 1533 and renovated by the Dutch in 1663:in the rooms the 17C painted murals of the Ramayana are depicted. Visit Jew town where you visit a 500 year old Synagogue. Jews were here during the time of King Solomon. In the afternoon we shall walk out of the hotel to the pier and take a boat ride to the Gulf of Arabia and see the fishing boats returning with their catch of prawns and fish. See the action of the daily catch etc.

Day 9 Cochin-Ooty

This morning we depart at 8 am for our bus drive to Ooty. We shall stop for lunch at the foothills of the Nilgiri Hills. We shall view some beautiful tea plantations in the hills and arrive in the late afternoon.

Day 10 Ooty-Mysore

Before we leave Ooty, you will have a chance to take a walk in the Botanical Gardens. Then we leave the Hills for our Journey to Mysore. We pass through a Wildlife Sanctuary on the way. After arriving the rest of day is at leisure in Mysore .

Day 11 Mysore

This morning our tour takes us up to Chamundi Hill, named after the Royal Families patron Goddess to the Temple. On the way down we shall see the Nandi (Siva's Bull) which is carved out of a single block of Granite. After we pay a visit to the market to see fresh vegetables and flowers. We will then proceed to see the Wooden Palace of Tipu Sultan. In the afternoon we shall pay a visit to the beautiful Indo Saracenic Palace of the Maharajah of Mysore.

Day 12 Mysore-Bangalore-Goa

This morning we leave Mysore for Bangalore airport where we leave for Goa. On the way we shall stop to see a sugar cane factory making Jageree, see the caves where the Passage to India was filmed. Rest of day at leisure once arriving at the hotel

Day 13 Goa

This morning we do a tour of Old Goa where we visit the Churches-Basilica of Bom Jesus etc and then on a walking tour of Panaji. Rest of day a leisure to swim, sunbath, have a massage or enjoy the view;

Day 14 Goa-Mumbai

This morning we transfer to the airport for our flight to Mumbai . On arriving we proceed to our hotel. In the afternoon we shall have a city tour passing by the Victoria Railway Terminus, the Queens Necklace, Jain Temple, pass by the Hanging gardens and the Tower of Silence where the Parsi 's dispose of their dead, a dhobi ghat where there is an outdoor laundry , and the Mani Bhavan where Mahatma Gandhi lived while in Bombay .Our hotel is situated across from the Gateway to India

Day 15 Mumbai-Jodhpur

We have an early am departure for our flight to Jodhpur. After our arrival, we proceed for check in at our hotel. This afternoon we shall visit the Immense Mehrangarh Fort It has a wealth of rich architecture and the Royal Cenotaphs of the Royal family of Jodhpur.

Day 16 Jodhpur

Today we will take a jeep safari to visit the Bisnoi and Rebari Villages. Here we will witness an Opium ceremony, pottery making and a dhurrie carpet weaving . Rest of day at leisure.

Day 17 Jodhpur-Jaipur

This morning we depart for our flight to Jaipur. We have arrived in the Pink City. This afternoon we shall pay a visit to the Amer Fort where we embark upon a gaily caparisoned elephant for a ride up to the Fort. We shall enter and see the beautiful Hall of Mirrors and the chambers of the Royal Family.

Day 18 Jaipur

This morning we shall stop at the Hawa Mahal (palace of the winds) for a photo opt and then proceed to the City Palace. First we shall visit the Observatory built by Maharajah Jai Singh in the 17C then on to see the City Palace Museum with its display of weaponry, fabrics, miniature paintings etc. Rest of day at leisure.

Overnight

Day 19 Jaipur-Sawai Madhopur (Ranthambhore)

This morning we depart for our drive to Sawai Madhopur. It is about a 3 to 4 hour drive. On arrival we check into our hotel and then leave for a game drive to Ranthambhore Tiger Reserve to see the elusive Tiger. View also a variety of wildlife and birds which inhabit the reserve.

Day 20 Sawai Madhopur- Jaipur


Early this morning another game viewing. After returning we have breakfast and then depart for Jaipur where we will have the rest of the day at leisure.

Day 21 Jaipur- Agra

This morning we depart by bus for Agra. After a lunch break we shall arrive at Fatehpur Sikri which is known as the Ghost capital of India. It was built of red sandstone by Emperor Akbar as his capital and later vacated due to a lack of water. Proceed to Agra

Day 22 Agra-Delhi

This morning we visit the Taj Mahal one of the most beautiful monuments in the world. It is built of pure white marble by Emperor Shah Jehan for his Consort Mumtaz Mahal . We will have a tour and then time to absorb the beauty and splendour of this monument. In the afternoon we shall visit the Agra Fort where Shah Jehan was imprisoned by his son.

This evening we shall depart for Delhi aboard the Shatabhi Express Train (20:18-23:00)

Day 23 Delhi

We shall have a tour of Old and New Delhi this afternoon. We shall visit the Raj Ghat (Mahatma Gandhi's cremation site), Qutab Minar, Bahai Temple, pass by the Diplomatic enclave and the Parliament buildings, Red Fort and the Jama Masjid Mosque etc.

Day 24 Delhi

Today will be at leisure to do whatever your heart desires. Shopping relaxing or museums. Later this evening we depart for our international flight home..

Day 25 Delhi – Home

Our flight leaves early in the morning for our flight home arriving the same day.

Day 1 Leave Delhi for our flight to Khajuraho. After arriving we check into our hotel and then proceed to visit the Temple Complex which was built from 950 AD to 1050 AD By the Chandela Kings See the beautiful sculptured Goddesses and the Erotic.

Day 2 Khajuraho- Varanasi

This afternoon we depart for our flight to Varanasi. On arrival, check into our hotel and then proceed to Senath which is the seat of Buddhism and also the National Museum.

Day 3 Varanasi- Delhi

Early this morning we shall leave the hotel at 5:30 to proceed to the Banks of the Ganges River. See the devotees praying and bathing in the river and on the boat as we go up river, see the dhobi gnats, and also the cremations taking Place. This is the holiest place for the Hindus Return to the hotel for breakfast and then we shall do a city tour visiting The Mother India Temple which is built of pure marble in the shape of India with its mountains plateaus etc. We shall leave in the afternoon for Delhi.

Day 4 Delhi-Home

Today at leisure. Do what your heart desires shopping, museums or relaxing. This late evening we depart for our flight Home.


